Location: East side of 1st St, near County Road 10E. Massage Therapy sign in front yard, driveway on south side of house. Drive around back and park between the house and the barn. Blacksmith shop is in the south side of the barn. (1/2 mile north of David Norrie's shop)

From I-25; take Berthoud Exit 250 (Hwy 56) west 5 miles to roundabout and go north 1-1/2 miles.

From US 287 northbound; take Berthoud exit east to roundabout and go north 1-1/2 miles.

From US 287 southbound; take Berthoud exit (3/4 mile south of Hwy 60) and continue 3/4 mile south.
